Chapter Five

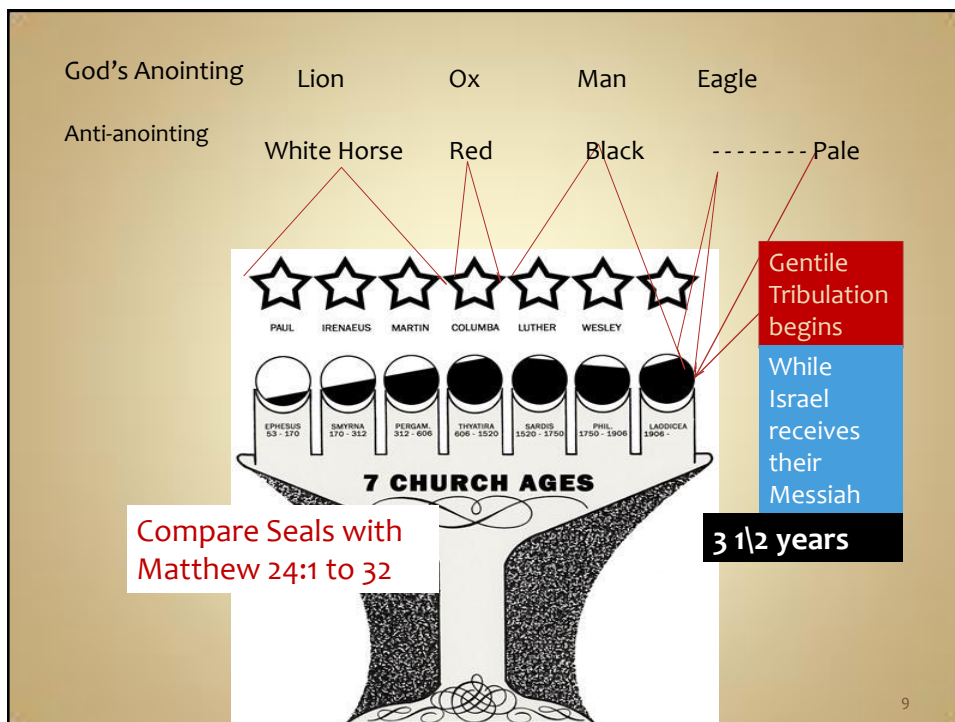
- Sets the scene for the “seals” of chapter 6
- This is not an action chapter, not a verse by verse something happening.
- A closed book (It is the book of redemption)
- Is there no one worthy to open this book?
- The lamb, with 7 eyes and 7 horns, takes the book from the hand of the original owner on the throne
 - Adam had forfeited it when he walked away from the Word.
- The lamb is seen no more, until chapter 19.
- Heaven breaks into worship
- *Thou... hast redeemed us; made us a kingdom of priests*

Chapter Six

- The seals hold the mystery of:
 - Redemption for the Gentile church 6:1-8 Seals 1 to 4
 - **Stopped here last session / Jump to next slide >>>>**
 - Redemption of elect Jews from Calvary to the rapture 6:9-11
 - They must wait until the 144,00 of chapter seven are killed as they were.
 - Redemption of the 144,000, the foolish virgins, earth's purging, and "the wrath of the lamb" (judgment on those who rejected grace)
 - 6:12 – 17 This is the "tribulation" seal
 - This now the "day of the Lord" or "the Lord's day" where John was looking back onto the church ages in Rev. 1:10-12
 - Let's place the first four seals over the church ages. [Slide 5]

Chapter Six

- The seals hold the mystery of:
 - First to fourth seal > Redemption for the Gentiles church 6:1-8
 - 5th Seal > Redemption of elect Jews from Calvary to the rapture 6:9-11
 - They must wait until the 144,00 of chapter seven are killed as they were. This actually happens in chapter 11.
 - 6th Seal >> 6:12 – 17 This is the “tribulation “ seal
 - Redemption of the 144,000, the foolish virgins, earth s’ purging, and “the wrath of the lamb” (judgment on those who rejected grace)
 - This now the “day of the Lord” or ‘the Lord’s day” where John was looking back onto the church ages in Rev. 1:10-12
 - The sixth seal finishes the mystery of redemption
 - “All the trumpets sounded under the sixth seal” F of T Para 147

THE FEAST OF THE TRUMPETS

Jeff. IN Sunday 64-0719M

147 The gathering of Israel is the Trumpets. The Trumpets is to gather Israel. Notice, the very First Trumpet sound; [Rev.8:7,8] blood, fire, hail, and everything, scatter the ground. See? What was He doing? Bringing Israel out of spiritual Egypt, see, back into his homeland.

148 Now let me say this right here, that, every Trumpet that blowed, blowed under the Sixth Seal. We'll get to it in a few minutes, where we caught the Seal there. All the Trumpets sounded under the Sixth Seal.

The Day of the Lord

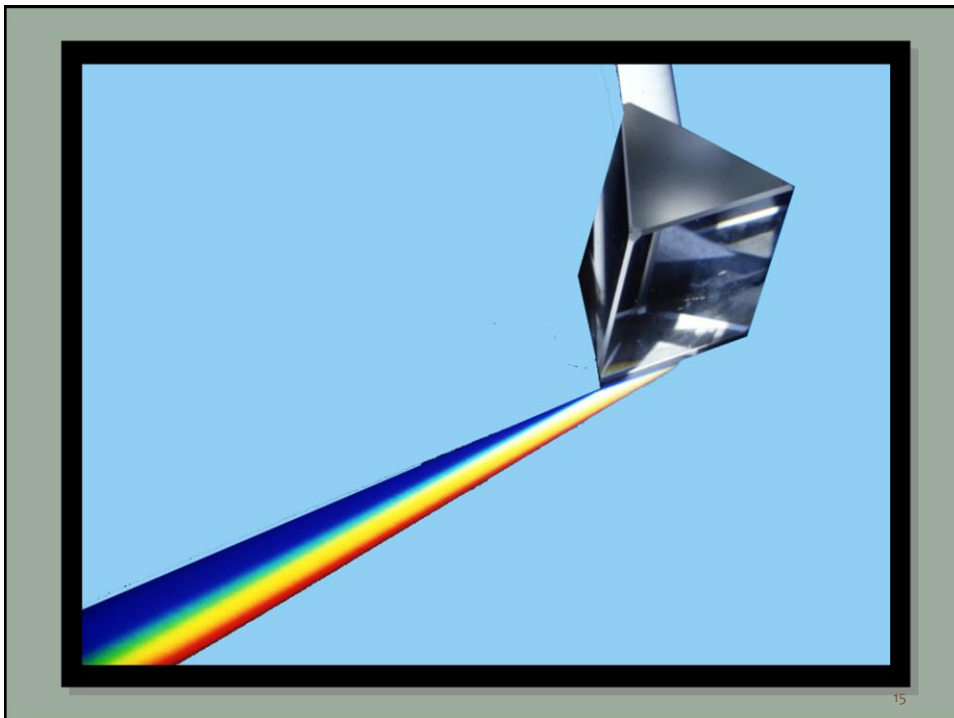
- II Peter 3:10,11
- II Peter 3:12 (Day of God)
- Isaiah 13:6-16 "it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty."
- Jeremiah 46:10 "... a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: ... "
- JOEL 1:15 "as a destruction from the Almighty shall it come.
- Joel 2:11 "... very terrible; and who can abide it?"
- JOEL 2:31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come.

Comparing to Rev. 6:12

- EXODUS 10:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, even darkness which may be felt.
- 22 And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days:
- 23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings
- JOEL 2:31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come. [Quoted in Acts 2:20 by Peter in his “this is that” sermon on the day of Pentecost]

Chapter Seven

- 7:1 – 3 WW I opened the sixth seal tribulation prematurely. At the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month the war was rather mysteriously called to a halt. God had work to do among the Jews.
- 7:4–8 144,000 elect Jews will be called out of the 12 tribes of Israel by the two witnesses of chapter eleven
- 7:9-17 THIS we will discuss.
- c/f Daniel 7 & 11:35 & 12:10 also Rev. 21:13 & 22:5

Chapter Eight

- The seventh seal = the coming of the Lord
- The first four trumpets begin to be declared
- Trumpets are to Israel what the seals were to the Gentiles --- they hold the mystery of how God redeemed.
- Numbers 10:1 – 10 / See the Leviticus 23 Feasts
- After four trumpets of chapter 8, there are yet three trumpets and three woes to come. [WWI WWII Armageddon]
